Income from members increased 9% as membership numbers continued to grow. Donations and interest income were slightly up. Sponsorship of the Design Awards partially covered the associated costs, and Events ran a small surplus. On the cost side, Better Bristol costs increased slightly, Society Organisation costs remained low as most activities including the AGM remained online and Working Group expenditure was flattered by a refund from Downs for People of the £1000 the Society donated in 2020 to support their legal case against the City Council. Overall the Society had a surplus of £6,700, increasing cash balances to £43,200.

Within the Project Account, income and costs for hosting the Neighbourhood Planning Network website flowed through the account. The balance was nil at year end.
